

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"KITCHEN KORNER"

STRAWBERRY SHORTCAKE JELLY ROLL



Ingredients:

- 1-5 cups of sliced strawberries (approx. 2lb.
- 2- 1/2cup of white sugar
- 3- Cover and chill
- 4- Preheat oven to 400*
- 5- Coat a 15 x10" jelly roll pan with cooking spray line bottom with Parchment Paper, spray paper with cooking spray set aside
- 6- 2/3 cup all purpose flour
- 7-1 teaspoon. Baking Power
- 8-1/4 teaspoon salt
- 9- Stir with whisk . Set aside
- 10- 1/2 cup white sugar
- 11-5 Egg Whites
- 12-3 Egg Yolks
- 13-2 teaspoons grated lemon rind
- 14-1 teaspoon Vanilla Extract
- 15- 10 oz (Approx). Strawberry Seedless Jam (prefer Smucker's)
- 16- 60z(Approx) Lemon Curd
- 17- Whip Cream

Directions:

- Place ½ cup white sugar and egg whites and egg yolks in large mixing bowl, beat with mixer at high speed until pale and fluffy (about 5 to 6 min).
- Stir in lemon rind and vanilla
- Sift half of flour mixture over egg mixture
- Fold in flour. Repeat procedure with remaining flour mixture
- Spoon batter into prepared pan evenly.

- Bake at 400* for 10 mins or until cake springs back when lightly touched in center.

- Remove from oven.
- Loosen all sides from edges of pan.
- Turn pan over on dish towel that has been dusted with powdered sugar (use small strainer or sifter for this sugar dusting).
- Carefully remove Parchment paper.
- Cool for a few minutes.
- Roll up cake and towel together.
- Set aside to cool completely.
- Unroll cake very carefully.
- Spread Lemon Curd on cake.
- Spread Strawberry Jelly leaving about 1/2"border around edge.
- Reroll your cake very carefully, holding it firm

and straight.

- Place on serving plate with seam at bottom to hold it closed.
- Slice and serve with your fresh sliced berries and Whip Cream. Serves 8. **ENJOY!**


