## Ingredients:

- 1 Tablespoon chopped fresh Rosemary
- 1 teaspoon olive oil
- ½ teaspoon kosher salt (divided)
- 1 garlic cloves minced
- 4 4ounce lamb loin chops trimmed)
- 1/8 teaspoon fresh ground black pepper Cooking Spray

- -Combine rosemary, oil, 1/4teaspoon salt, and garlic.
- -Rub mixture over both sides of the lamb chop.
- -Cover and marinate in fridge at least 3hrs. Or overnight




